

Spiritual Life Student Leader Descriptions

Head Life Leader Scholarship Requirements

Head Life Leaders engage in relational ministry for the purpose of teaching the Bible to the GCU community and growing as spiritual leaders on campus. Head Life Leaders faithfully hold weekly Bible studies, make themselves available to other students for spiritual counsel as well as support and engage in one-on-one mentoring relationships with Small Group Leaders. Head Life Leaders will oversee between two and four Small Group leaders by providing training, discipleship and guidance. Head life leaders support the mission and initiatives of the Department of Spiritual Life.

Small Group Leader Scholarship Requirements

Small Group Leaders engage in relational ministry for the purpose of teaching the Bible to the GCU community and growing as spiritual leaders on campus. Small Group Leaders faithfully hold weekly Bible studies, make themselves available to other students for spiritual counsel and support as well as engage in one-on-one mentoring relationships with Head Life Leaders. Small Group Leaders support the mission and initiatives of the Department of Spiritual Life.

Global Outreach (GO) Leader Requirements

Global Outreach mobilizes students to develop a thriving faith and increasing desire for making disciples of all nations, producing kingdom impact in all areas of life. Opportunities include; befriending international students, disciple making small groups, supporting refugees, prayer, global awareness events, global outreach intro groups and connecting students with global opportunities.

Local Outreach Leader Requirements

Local Outreach oversees a variety of ministries that serve the greater Phoenix area. Local Outreach leaders mobilize other students to volunteer in the community and foster relationships with our GCU neighborhoods. Ministries include Canyon Kids, Colter Commons, Youth Outreach, Streetlight, Homeless Ministry, Prison Ministry, Changing Lives Center, Neighborhood Ministries and Habitat for Humanity.

Worship Team Requirements

Students who are selected for worship team scholarships should demonstrate an active relationship with Jesus, as they are servant leaders who facilitate worship for students and staff. These students should also be gifted and experienced in the scholarship position they apply for (i.e. vocal, drums, sound tech, etc.). Both spiritual leadership and musical ability are essential components in selecting student leaders who serve in the worship teams.

Please note that students are only eligible for one leadership position (i.e. a student cannot be an RA as well as a member of the worship team).
